



KARA-TUNGA ECO CAMPS

A unique opportunity for an immersive cultural experience in an unspoiled natural environment that positively impacts the local communities and supports the conservation of biodiversity.

The camps are thoughtfully located with a panoramic view of the untouched landscapes, front row seats of the African sunrise and an unspoiled view of the bright stars.







FOOD AND DRINKS

The camps have an onsite restaurant offering daily meals with full-board and half-board options. Due their remoteness, It's advisable to book meals in advance.



ACCOMMODATION

The non-self-contained canvas tents (lazy camping) have a veranda with safari chairs, 120cm long single beds, solar lighting, linen, toiletries and walking distance from the washrooms.





TIMU FOREST

Timu Eco-Camp is located on the East African Rift escapement at an altitude of 2,000m. The location offers a breathtaking view of the surrounding landscape, amidst the indigenous ik community.



MOUNT MORUNGOLE

Morungole Eco-Camp is a historical resting place for the hunters-gatherers community and is located at the foot of Mount Morungole. It's located in the midst of the woodland and offers access to the summit using ancestral trails.





COMMUNITY BENEFIT SHARING

Each guest contributes towards the conservation of the surrounding environment through a levy of 10% paid on top of the bednight fee.

75% of the tourist activities fee directly benefits the community through the engagement of site guides, community groups and local service providers.

OUTDOOR ADVENTURE

The Ik tribe are former hunter-gatherers and farmers and today live in the extreme northeastern corner of the country. They are known for their love for the environment and their cultural heritage.

You will find stunningly beautiful Scenery the higher your climb takes you, simply breathtaking scenes in the valleys below you and into the Eastern Rift Valley of Kenya and over to Southern Sudan.




ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

- Payments can be made upon arrival by cash (USD or UGX). USD notes must be dated 2009 or newer and free of any marks, stamps or tears to be accepted. The exact amount in UGX will be determined by the monthly exchange rate determined by the Uganda Revenue Authority. Find the current rates on our website.
- Payments can be done via Credit Card (transaction fee of 2.5% in 2024, 0% from 2025) (Mastercard, VISA and American Express).

 Please cancel 48 hours before scheduled arrival to avoid cancellation charge (equal to the first night of your stay).


DISCOUNTS
